



## 2018 Poll Challenger Information

Poll Challengers must be assigned by a party entity (eg. the MNGOP).

Duty is to observe the election process and challenge the votes of anyone they *know* is ineligible to vote. “Know” is determined by personal knowledge (ie. you overhear someone in line saying they already voted at another precinct) or you know the individual personally.

Each political party is allowed one challenger per precinct. All training and scheduling is created and coordinated at the state level but delivered through a Congressional District volunteer.

Poll Challengers will be assigned late summer 2018.

Poll challenger requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a Minnesota resident
- Must be eligible and registered to vote  
(ie. a citizen, not a felon, mentally competent, etc.)

Poll Challengers are VOLUNTEERS  
they are NOT paid  
and

they do NOT get paid time off from work.

Indicate your desire to serve as a Poll Challenger by completing the Volunteer Card.
